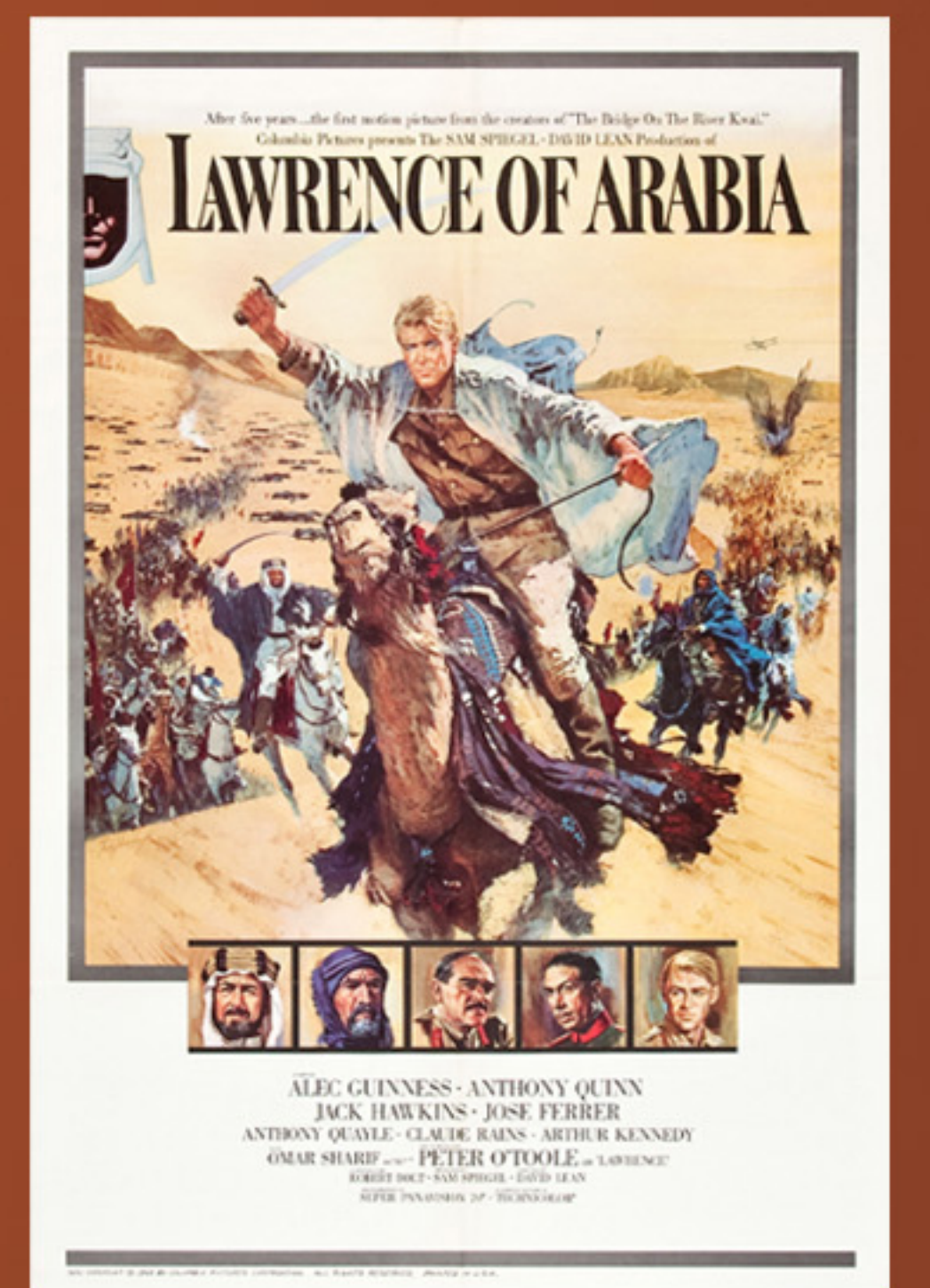
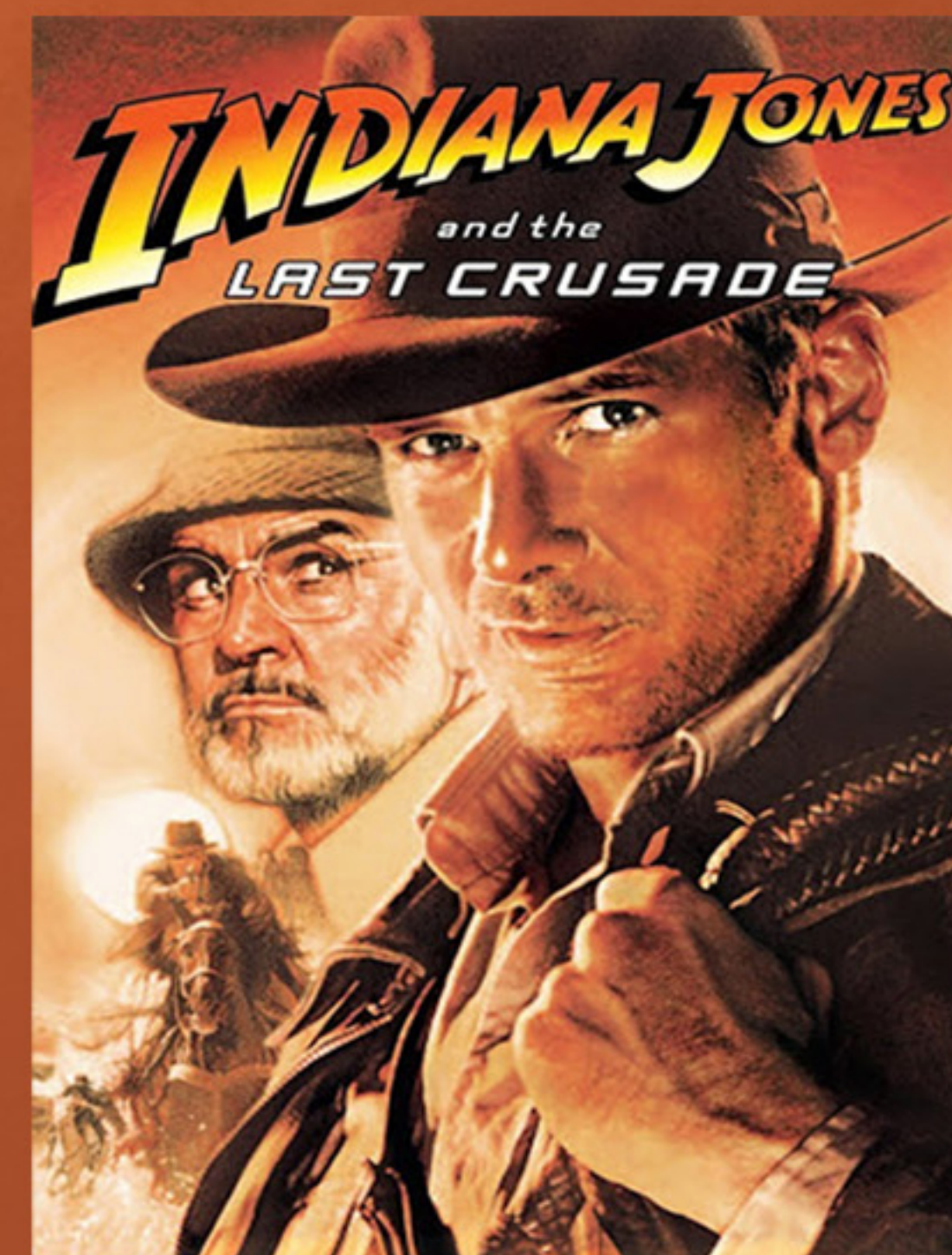
## ON THE SILVER SCREEN

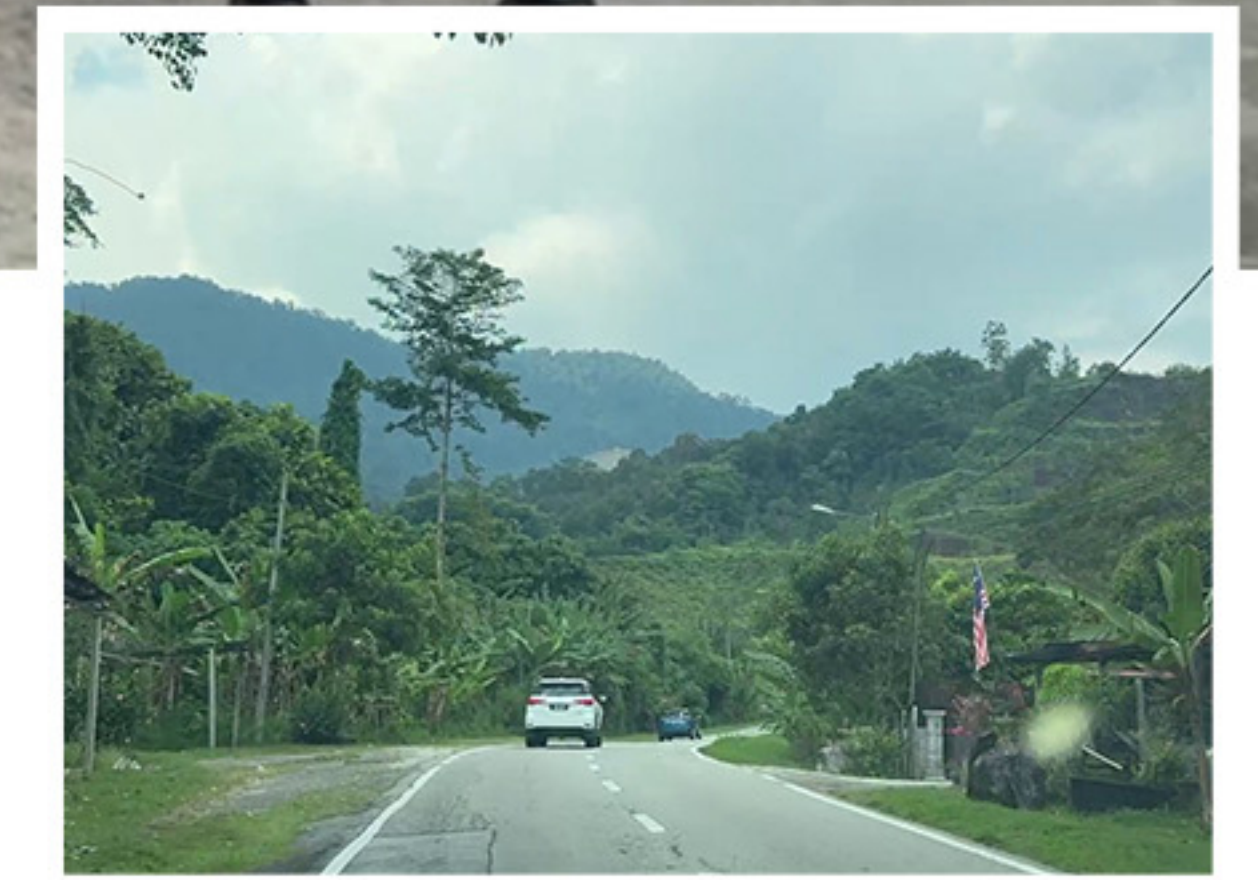

## Arrival in Amman

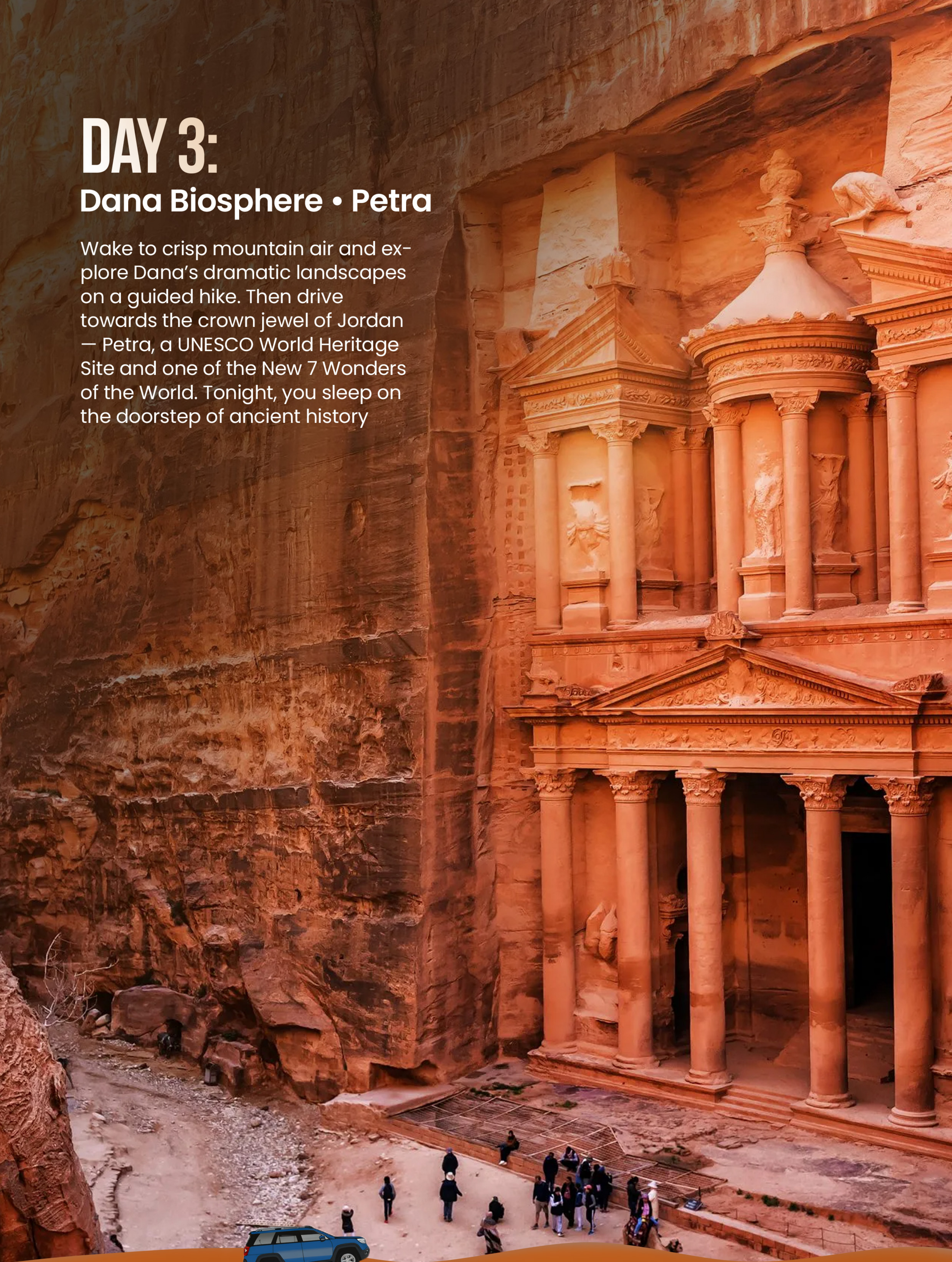




# DAY 3:
