- Learning basic Thai greetings like "Sawasdee" (hello) and "Khob khun" (thank you) is appreciated.
- Polite particles like "krap" (male speakers) and "kha" (female speakers) are often added to show respect.
- Respect for hierarchy and elders is very important in Thai society.
- The "wai" greeting (palms pressed together) is common and a sign of respect.
- Smiling is valued as a way to maintain harmony and show politeness.
- Avoid public displays of anger or confrontation—it's considered losing face.
- Temples are sacred places: dress modestly, remove shoes, and behave respectfully.
- The head is the most sacred part of the body, so don't touch anyone's head.
- Feet are considered the lowest and dirtiest part—avoid pointing them at people or religious objects



HEALTH AND VACCINATIONS

- Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Typhoid, Diphtheria, and routine shots.
- Wear long sleeves and pants in high-risk areas (especially rural or jungle zones). Use repellent.
- Choose comprehensive coverage for medical emergencies, accidents, & trip cancellations

- Don't litter – keep public places clean.
- Follow traffic rules – obey speed limits and drive on the left.
- Always show respect to monks—women should not touch them

FOOD AND WATER SAFETY

- Drink only bottled or filtered water—avoid tap water and ice from unknown sources.
- Eat freshly cooked food—hot food is safer than raw or cold dishes.
- Be cautious with street food—choose busy stalls with high turnover for fresher food.
- Avoid raw or undercooked meat, seafood, and eggs.
- Wash your hands before eating or use hand sanitizer.
